Dear Parent/Carer,

I am delighted to be writing to you with details of the Outwood Academy Bishopsgarth Olympics which will take place on Friday 16 July 2021. The day will include a range of sports and activities including an inflatable assault course, athletics, mountain bike course and basketball.

Students should arrive at school at the normal time and be in their tutor room ready to commence activities at 8.25am. The day will finish as normal, with all students leaving the site by 2.30pm. We look forward to all students participating in our Olympics: please note that attendance will be recorded as normal.

All students should arrive at school wearing their full PE kit, shorts and polo shirt, tracksuit bottoms and rugby top if desired, to ensure they are suitably dressed to take part in the Sports Day whatever their role on the day. Please note that hoodies are not allowed to be worn on the school site, but black leggings may be worn instead of black shorts or tracksuit bottoms on this occasion.

Students in Year 9 and Year 10 have not been changing into PE kit for lessons during this academic year so may be unable to wear full PE kit for our Olympics. Students in Years 9 and 10 only will therefore be allowed to wear black shorts/tracksuit bottoms/leggings and a plain T-shirt. Crop tops or vests are not appropriate for wearing in school.

A packed lunch, including a bottle of water, will be provided for all students to aid the flow of activities during the day. Students may wish to bring additional water or healthy snacks, but please note that, as always, sweets, chocolates, large bags of crisps and fizzy drinks are not permitted in school.


