Each subject area has identified relevant sources of evidence to support the assessment grades. These pieces of evidence will be marked, standardised and then samples of work will be quality assured. In some cases there will be support from external verifiers (mainly in BTEC subjects) to assess the accuracy of the awards.

Please note that this is only a sample of the work as in some cases students have completed additional evidence pieces and there have been submissions of other assessment opportunities to build the evidence. Evidence may include, but may not be limited to:

- Student work produced in response to assessment materials provided by the exam board, including questions, past papers or similar materials
- Non exam assessment work
- Student work produced in tasks designed/devised by the academy (which may include activities that took place during remote learning)
- Records of a student's capability and performance over the course of study.
